

## **Minutes – Late Swingers Spring Meeting**

**March 26, 2009**

Michele Brown, League Administrator, welcomed the group of approximately 47 and introduced Pro Kirk Schooley. Kirk invited all to attend golf clinics Tuesdays and Thursdays at 6:00pm during April. Meetings will alternate between Juniper and Lakeview. Though geared for beginners, all can benefit.

Michele Brown reported that Charlie Lewis from Lakeview Park had originally planned to speak at our meeting, but had a last minute conflict. He was going to let ladies know he was trying to establish a Tuesday night league at Lakeview. Michele will notify members once something is decided for sure.

Reviewed Rules of Play. League play begins at 2:30 for all members except those working at sign in table and with 4-holers.

Division I handicaps 0-39

Division II handicaps 40+

Only Division II players with handicaps of 40-43 can play with Division I and will be counted as handicap of 39 for prize eligibility. Division I players playing with Division II are not eligible for prizes.

No caddies or coaches are allowed during league play. Spectators must maintain 30 yard distance.

Members are encouraged to be aware of pace of play. Rangers may be on course during season to assist.

Members were referred to the important dates for the season. September scramble may not occur.

Review of requirements for participation in Ladies' Club Championship.

On April 23rd, the week before league play begins, a scramble will be held with a shotgun start at 5:00pm. League membership is not required and all ladies are invited to participate. Proceeds will benefit the Frankfort Women's Shelter.

Michele advised members that Miss Dollie Wilson, a founding member of the league, had passed away this winter. Miss Dollie was active in the league into her eighties and was much loved. The mid-season fun night is named in her honor.

Shirley Rodgers reviewed changes to the by-laws recommended by the By-Laws committee and

moved that they be adopted. Motion was seconded by Trina Roberts. Motion passed.

The drink cart will be provided again this year by Brad Reynolds. Tips are accepted.

Pam Rhodes was introduced as the caretaker of the league. She sends cards for illnesses and deaths on behalf of the league/

Michele explained the Joint Ladies League Committee's actions in implementing handicap functions separate from the men. Shirley Rodgers recommended that in the future expenditures made by the committee be approved by the membership. It was agreed that that is certainly the preferred method, though time constraints may prevent it. Because of the work of the committee, the first handicap revision will be available on April 22. Corrections to handicaps will be easier in the future. Tournament pairing will be available.
